## **THE MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2024**

### **This Sunday's Scripture**

Today we celebrate Corpus Christi, which means the body of Christ we receive in Holy Communion. Jesus sacrifices Himself for us. This self-sacrifice is made present again in Holy Communion and in the Mass. The first prayer of the Mass prays that we receive the Eucharist fruitfully. We pray that we will always see the Mass and communion as a meeting with Jesus to be treasured, rather than as a shallow ritual to be dismissed.

**Sacred Heart of Jesus:** This Friday we celebrate the love of God for us. The sacred heart statue shows the heart of Jesus pierced out of love for us as He sacrificed Himself on the cross.
