FEAST of the HOLY FAMILY: 29th December 2024

This Sunday's Scripture, The Feast of the Holy Family: reminds us that God chose to be born into a family like our family. In doing so, God blesses your family. The stability of the human race depends on strong families that stick together and support each other. The Holy Family experienced all the ups and downs we too experience, but they remained strong as they stuck together. We also remember that we are part of a family of faith, where we let the message of Christ in all its richness find a home in our hearts. We are strong by sticking together in faith.

Wednesday January 1st: We celebrate the feast of 'Mary, Mother of God' today. Holy Mass at Holy Trinity & St George, Kendal 12.00pm.

Jubilee (Holy) Year 2025

Pope Francis will open a Holy Year for the entire Catholic Church in 2025. These special years of grace take place every 25 years and are an opportunity for spiritual renewal. The theme of this Holy Year will be 'Pilgrims of Hope'. The focus of a Holy Year is the pilgrimage to the tombs of the apostles SS Peter and Paul in Rome which has special indulgences attached and is a chance to return to the sources of our faith in the early Church. However, the Holy Father wishes this to be celebrated across the Church as well, in each local diocese. He has asked that this Holy Year be opened solemnly in every Catholic cathedral in the world on 29th December this year. Bishop Paul will celebrate 10.30 Mass in the cathedral to inaugurate the Holy Year for our diocese. Mass will begin outside the West (main) Door of the Cathedral. The liturgy of the opening of the Holy Year will consist of 4 steps:

- Prayers outside the Cathedral with reading of the Papal Bull (decree) inaugurating the Holy Year.
- Solemn Opening of the main doors of the cathedral with the Bishop leading the people into the House of God behind the medieval processional cross from Cockersands Abbey.
- Blessing and Sprinkling of Holy Water.
- Solemn Celebration of Mass beginning with the Gloria.

GRANGE News:

World Apostolate of Fatima, England and Wales, First Saturday Devotion 4th January 2025. We no longer have a Mass at St Charles on Saturdays, but we can meet at 10am to pray the Rosary for world peace. Maybe our prayers can achieve what politicians fail to achieve!

The First Saturday Devotion Explained

Each part of the devotion below should be made in a spirit of reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months:

- **1. Go to confession:** The Child Jesus told Lucia that you can go to confession within eight days or even later, provided that when you receive Him, you are in a state of grace and intend to make reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
- **2. Receive Holy Communion:** The Communion of reparation must be sacramental and must be made during the twenty-four hours of the first Saturday or, for justifiable reasons, on the Sunday following the first Saturday.
- **3. Recite five decades of the Rosary:** In his Apostolic Letter on the Rosary, John Paul II says the mysteries "put us in living communion with Jesus through we might say the heart of His Mother". The Rosary confers "abundant grace", it offers a fruitful opportunity for the new evangelisation, and will counter the forces which threaten the family (Rosarium Virginis Mariae, 2, 3, 6).
- **4. Meditate on the mysteries for fifteen minutes:** "Without contemplation, the Rosary is a body without a soul", wrote Pope Paul VI. In the Rosary, "Mary constantly sets before the faithful the mysteries of her Son", so that by contemplation "they will release all their saving power". The Rosary is a compendium of the Gospel in which, in union with Mary, we "learn from her to 'read' Christ, to discover His secrets and to understand His message" (Rosarium Virginis Mariae, 1, 11, 14).

WHY ON FIVE SATURDAYS? Our Lord revealed to Sr Lucia that the devotion was in reparation for the five offences and blasphemies against Our Lady: blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception, against Mary's virginity, against her Divine Maternity, and by those who seek to alienate children from her; and reparation for those who outrage Our Lady in her sacred images.
