# FEAST of CHRIST the KING - 24th NOVEMBER 2024

This Sunday's Scripture: Christ the King Today is the Feast of Christ the King. It marks the end of the church's year. Jesus came to bring His kingdom and His rule to our needy world: '... a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace ...' (Preface). Jesus is raised from the dead, the conqueror of sin and death, and He offers the resurrection to us all. All who are on the side of truth listen to the voice of Jesus.
