FIRST SUNDAY of ADVENT (Year B)

This Sunday's Scripture: The Gospel tells us to "stay awake". We are to be alert to the signs of God acting in our world today, so that His coming at our death will not take us by surprise tomorrow.

Advent begins, a time when we prepare our hearts and minds to welcome the coming of Jesus at Christmas. We recognise three comings of God: the past, the present and in the future. Today we join those who yearned for his coming in past ages, and promise to stay awake to the signs of his coming into our lives today.

Advent Preparations: Prepare a Place for Jesus: We are going to help prepare a place for Jesus this Christmas, by building the crib in Advent. When we prepare the crib outside us, we also prepare another crib inside our hearts to welcome Jesus afresh. This Sunday we promise to follow the guidance of a star in Advent, which symbolises the guidance of scripture.
