**Palm Sunday – Holy Week**

### **The Sacred Triduum**

‘**Triduum**’ means ‘Three Days’. These days are the centre of our Christian faith. All the faithful should try to attend as much as possible of the Triduum.

**Here are the events:**

#### **MAUNDY THURSDAY**



**Mass of Chrism** at the Cathedral at 11.30am, to which all parishioners are invited. Here the priests of the diocese renew their promises to serve their people faithfully, (and to make Christ present again in each parish through the sacraments). The Bishop blesses the sacred oils that are used in the sacraments.

**Evening Mass of the Lords Supper at 7.00pm.** We become present at the Last Supper, the First Mass. We also receive the Holy Oils that will be used in the coming year. There will be **watching at the Altar of Repose** until 9.00pm.





## GOOD FRIDAY

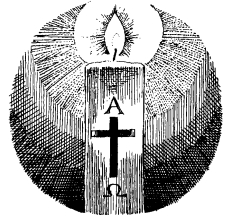
### Solemn Liturgy of the Passion and Death of Our Lord

at 3.00pm, at both Grange and Milnthorpe. We sorrow that the sins of the world should require such loving self-sacrifice. Also the Good Friday stations of the cross (Grange 11am) and the walk of witness (Arnside 10am) and at Milnthorpe 10am on the Green.

**Holy Saturday Day:** We watch and wait in quiet, preparing for the resurrection. Office 10am Grange.

**HOLY SATURDAY EVENING:** Easter Vigil 8.00pm, Milnthorpe. This is the mother of all vigils, the centre of the Christian year. God comes personally in Jesus the one who 'broke the chains of death and rose triumphant from the grave' (Exultet). (Easter Day Masses at Grange 9.30am and Arnside 11.00am)



### REHEARSAL FOR HOLY THURSDAY- MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER.
