This Sunday's Scripture: Christ the King Today is the Feast of Christ the King. It marks the end of the church's year. Jesus is raised from the dead, the conqueror of sin and death, and He offers the resurrection to us all. All who are on the side of truth listen to the voice of Jesus.
