Feedback on 'What Next':

Thank you to the 22 people who completed the questionnaire. The responses for St Charles have been collated and are displayed in the St Joseph's Chapel. Please do take the time to read them. You will also find a summary of the responses to the 4 questions and the opportunity to think deeper about 'What Next'. The Bishop has accepted an invitation to meet with the PPC from St Charles as a result of the letter we sent. (Copy of the letter can be found in the St Joseph's Chapel) This will be an opportunity for the PPC to talk to Bishop Paul on your behalf and ask him for advice particularly on our Sunday obligation and many other questions and concerns you may have. So please if you have any further questions or concerns, please put them in the PPC box (which you will find in St Joseph's Chapel) by the end of June.

Lectionaries: "Since, in liturgical celebrations the books serve as signs and symbols of the sacred, care must be taken to ensure that they truly are worthy and beautiful" (Vatican II)

The new altar books are required from Advent 2024. Each of our churches has stated their preference for the size of the lectionaries. Costs as follows: Large Lectionary books x 4 £695.00; compact chapel lectionaries x 4 £395.00 (chosen by Milnthorpe & Arnside); Processional Gospel book for each church: £275.00 (more expensive with a silver front piece).

I am glad to say that as a result of two very generous donations from Grange of £700.00 and £500.00 the lectionaries and a fine gospel book with a silver front piece have been more than paid for.
