ALL SAINTS DAY 31st October 2021

All Saints: We celebrate the beautiful feast of All Saints this Sunday. It is a time when we feel very close to the holy ones who live beyond this world, but who are in close contact with us. They pray for us and support us, and we honour them. (Mass times are the usual Sunday Mass times). Our November list envelopes will be placed before the altar

This Sunday's Scripture

‘Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven’. We pray that we will join the Saints in heaven, urged on as we are by them.

Holy Souls (Tuesday 2 November) is the feast of those who have died, but realise that they are not ready to meet God yet in His beauty and holiness. They submit to being cleansed spiritually so that they can join God. We help them with our prayers. Mass of All Souls at Grange at 9.30am; at Grange we also have the traditional service in the afternoon at the Cemetery (meet at the cemetery gates at 3.00pm).

November Lists: Please enclose in the envelope, a list of those who you wish to put before God. They will be placed at the altar. If you wish a specific intention for deceased, whether a named family group or for the dead generally during November you should put in a separate Mass intention.
