#### **This Sunday's Scripture**

God will always provide for the future if we are generous. Jesus noticed the poor widow's tiny offering to the temple, which was made out of love, and out of the little she had. The lesson is that we should give lovingly and generously to God, and to those in need, of our money, our time and our talents. God will always repay such generosity, as he did the widow in the first reading.
