This Sunday's Scripture

The readings today remind us that we cannot divide our religion from daily life, and that our religion is deeply personal but never private: There is always a community aspect. The commandments are about acting rightly both with God and also our neighbour. Jesus Himself calls God His Father. He later commands us to call God "Our Father". We must therefore be responsible to others as our brothers and sisters who have the same Father in heaven.
