- Monday 19th July those 8 Martyrs of Lancashire who were martyred elsewhere.
- Friday 24th July those 10 martyrs of Cumbria, who were all martyred elsewhere except for Christopher Robinson of Carlisle. My last presbytery at Goosnargh near Preston was the birthplace of Fr. George Beesley, one of the martyrs commemorated.
- We pray that our faith will be strengthened by their sacrifice. May we live a life of strong and generous faith, as our martyrs did.

- To support and encourage our parishioners to be truly confident, outward looking, welcoming and missionary, as Pope Francis urges.
- Intercession is our privilege of mediation between another person or persons and God (The first mediatrix is Our Lady).
