Today we hear the parable of the fruitless fig tree. We learn that God requires us to be fruitful spiritually if we are to keep our place in the kingdom, or vineyard of God. Salvation is not automatic. But we also remember that God is compassion & love. He is the one who is always present for us. "I am who am". He is close to us in the person of Jesus; We come back to God who is generous and welcoming and supportive.
