# Palm Sunday – Holy Week



Holy Week is the most sacred week of the year. It begins with Palm Sunday, when we become the people of 2000 years ago who welcomed Jesus into His city of Jerusalem. From then on, we accompany Jesus with His disciples through His passion and His death to rejoice with Him in His resurrection. **Every Catholic should strive to attend all the parts of Holy Week.** They only make full sense when put together.

# The Sacred Triduum

**'Triduum'** means 'Three Days'. These days are the centre of our Christian faith. All the faithful should try to attend as much as possible of the Triduum. Our Lord was certainly tried and executed for claiming two things: that He was a King and that He was God. He claimed that the truth would be revealed when, after His execution, He would rise again. If He did not rise again, then our faith would be in vain. He said it and did it. Therefore our faith, which we hold in its fullness as Catholics, is true.

### MAUNDY THURSDAY

**Mass of Chrism** at the Cathedral at 11.30, to which all parishioners are invited. Here the priests of the diocese renew their promises to serve their people faithfully, and to make Christ present again in each parish through the sacraments. The bishop blesses the sacred oils that are used in the sacraments.

**Evening Mass of the Lords Supper at 7.00pm**. The Triduum proper begins (7.00pm Grange on Holy Thursday). We become present at the Last Supper, when Our Lord summed up His self-sacrifice in a sacred meal, the Mass. We also receive the Holy Oils that will be used in the coming year. There will be **watching at the Altar of Repose** until 9.00. We become the disciples in the Garden who were told to 'watch and wait with Me' We will end with the Night Prayer of the Church.





### **GOOD FRIDAY**

**Solemn Liturgy of the Passion and Death of Our Lord** at 3.00pm, at both Grange and Milnthorpe. We walk with Our Lord to his execution, sorrowing that the sins of the world should require such loving selfsacrifice. On Good Friday morning, Grange 10.00am Office of Readings and Morning Prayer, followed by Stations of the Cross at 11.00am. Arnside 10.00am Walk

of witness and Milnthorpe 10.00am Service of Witness on the Green.

Holy Saturday Day: We watch and wait in quiet, preparing for the resurrection.

# Easter

**HOLY SATURDAY** Easter Vigil 8.00pm, Milnthorpe. This is mother of all vigils, the centre of the Christian year. The light of Christ comes into our world. We travel through the history of the Old Testament. God reveals Himself as the saving God. Finally, God comes personally in Jesus, the one who 'broke the chains of death and rose triumphant from the grave' (Exultet). (Easter Day Masses at Grange 9.30am and Arnside 11.00 am)
