This Sunday's Scripture

Christ is the bread of life. Jesus wants us to find the bread that lasts, bread that feeds the soul: He wants us to come to Himself. This means renewing our minds by a spiritual revolution, so that we see the value of what Jesus offers, rather than search after material things alone. He says: "work for the food that endures to eternal life"

Transfiguration

Tuesday: Jesus is transfigured and is seen as the glorious being He really is. He shone like the power of the sun. The response of the apostles is awe and wonder, with fear. Tuesday is also the anniversary of the dropping of the first atomic bomb on Hiroshima. We reflect on the way that we warp and misuse God's creation and ask that we will always use His world for the good of mankind.

Mockery of Christianity: We join with Catholics and many Christians throughout the world in a short act of reparation this Sunday for an act of "gross mockery" of Jesus and the Christian faith. The opening ceremony of the Olympic games contained a tableaux which included "scenes of mockery and derision of Christianity" aimed at the Mass, the Eucharist and Our Lord Himself. The response of our faith is to make reparation in common with Christians throughout the world, and to pray for souls involved in thinking up such a gross insult. I invite you to say during the Mass the following prayer:

Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son, Holy Ghost, I adore You profoundly. I offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifference with which He Himself is offended. Through the infinite merits of His most Sacred Heart, and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of You the conversion of poor sinners. Amen
