Sale of 2-6 Pier Lane Arnside - This property was the location of the first Catholic Church in Arnside from 1926-1977. Since then, it has been a useful source of commercial rental income for the Parish. Interest in the property from small businesses has declined since the Covid pandemic and the property is now empty. All efforts to find new commercial tenants have not been successful. The Parish Finance Group, having considered a range of options, advised Fr Philip that the property was surplus to requirements and should be sold. An application to sell the property has been approved by the Diocesan Trustees and the sale is now underway. It is planned to invest the proceeds of the sale in other property projects in the Parish.
